

**POLICY**

Applicants who have doctorates from educational institutions outside the United States or Canada are required to obtain an equivalence evaluation from a nationally recognized service used by universities for similar purposes. Appropriate organizations are members of The National Association of Credential Evaluator Services (NACES). The Entrance Examiner and staff shall refer candidates requiring review of a non-U.S. degree to [www.NACES.org](http://www.NACES.org). The rule governing this process is found in OAC 4732-9-01.2.
