


**POLICY STATEMENTS AND GUIDELINES**

- 1) Supervisees who solely gather data for the license holder need not be named in any related psychological report, although supervisees who interpret psychological data shall be named in a psychological report. This does not prohibit license holders from naming the supervisees who administer testing without participating in test interpretation of report writing.
- 2) Licensed school psychologists are qualified to provide services required in Child/Adolescent Partial Hospitalization Programs. The Board will provide this information in writing to the Ohio Department of Mental Health (ODMH) indicating the Board's assumption that licensed School Psychologists are included with the category Psychologist in the ODMH Eligible Providers and Supervisors Matrix. The assumption is based on RC 4732.01 (B) noting that the practice of psychology includes the practice of school psychology.
