REQUIREMENTS TO BE REGISTERED: Please follow the instructions on the application cover page. You cannot be registered for the workshop/exam until we have received the application and \$125 fee, a recent photograph, three acceptable letters of reference, and the signed receipt for the pre-certification workshop law and rules manual. There is no requirement to submit any academic transcripts. We will verify your BCBA on the Web. You must complete a background check specifically for the Ohio Board of Psychology. PREPARING FOR THE WORKSHOP: A 2-hour workshop on the law and rules governing Certified Ohio Behavior Analysts will be immediately followed by a 20-item "closed book" written examination. Candidates are expected to prepare for the workshop by devoting 8-10 hours studying the pre-certification workshop law and rules manual. During the workshop, the law and rules will be reviewed and questions will be fielded and discussed.
