

## **NOTICE OF RULE CHANGE PROPOSALS AND COMMENT PERIOD**

The Ohio Board of Psychology is proposing to amend rule 4732-5-01 and to rescind and replace rule 4732-5-02. These rules are filed with the Common Sense Initiatives Office and are available for comment about adverse impacts. This notice is posted pursuant to Executive Order 2011-01K and Sections 107.62 and 121.82 of the Ohio Revised Code, which require state agencies to draft rules in collaboration with stakeholders, assess and justify any adverse impact on the business community, and provide opportunity for the affected public to provide input on the proposed rules. The Business Impact Analysis filed with the Common Sense Initiatives Office discusses the purpose of the rules and identifies the nature of the potential adverse impact on businesses and our regulated community.
