Notice of Proposed Rule Filing

This is posted pursuant to the requirements of Executive Order 2011-01K and SB2 of the 129th General Assembly, which require state agencies, including the State Board of Psychology, to draft rules in collaboration with stakeholders, assess and justify any adverse impact on the business community (as defined by SB2), and provide an opportunity for the affected public to provide input on the rules.

Rule changes are being proposed to require a consistent amount of training supervision regardless of program accreditation, to empower psychologists to delegate psychological diagnosis, psychological client supervision and psychological prescription to psychological work supervisees, to and to reorganize and clarify the chapter of supervision rules.

Comments on the proposed rules will be accepted until close of business on March 14, 2018.
