

## **Notice of Proposed Rule Filing**

This message is posted pursuant to the requirements of Executive Order 2011-01K and Senate Bill 2 (SB2) of the 129<sup>th</sup> General Assembly, which requires state agencies, including the State Board of Psychology, to draft rules in collaboration with stakeholders, assess and justify any adverse impact on the business community (as defined by SB2), and provide an opportunity for the affected public to provide input on the rules.

A new rule is being proposed to comply with requirements in HB487. In that bill, ORC 3707.511 requires affected licensing boards to write rules relative to the minimum educational and practice standards required for healthcare professionals to assess and authorize return-to-play clearance for youth athletes removed from practice or competition due to concussion.

The proposed new rule subject to potential adverse impact on businesses is:
